After 28... ♗h5 29 ♞xh5 ♙xh6 (29... ♞xh6 30 ♞xf8+-) 30 ♖c2!, despite the fact that Black has three defenders for the Bishop, all efforts fail to White's threatened attack, because the Queen has no squares to protect h6 other than along the 6<sup>th</sup> rank, and Black is just one move short of reversing the Queen and the Rook on the 6<sup>th</sup> rank. If Black plays ... ♙xe3, he not only is down an exchange, but White gets a winning attack with all his pieces against Black's open King.

Things are not better even if Black doesn't capture the h-pawn immediately, e.g.,

A) 29... ♖e8 30 h7 ♞g6 31 ♞g5 (32 ♞xf8! also wins.) 31... ♞xg5 32 ♖xg5 ♞xh7 33 ♖xd5, with threats of 34 ♖g8 and 34 ♞f6, wins.
